THE ART STUDIO TOUR features open artisans' studios providing a rare, intimate view of the artist and their work during the creative process. These artisans include painters, sculptors, potters, weavers, jewelers, woodworkers, and more. Many of the studios are open only for this event, providing a unique opportunity to meet the artists in their environment, purchase their work, and see how it is created. Visitors will have the opportunity to ask questions and discuss the artists' work.

You will be able to visit charming studios throughout the greater Green Bay area and the Lakeshore. Beautiful scenery and magnificent fall color on the drive through the autumn countryside enhance the ride between studios. The free self-guided tour is designed so you can plan your own route. Watch for Art Studio Tour signs at key intersections along the way leading you to your destination.



1. Paul M. Murphy
Paul M. Murphy Studio
Pyrography (drawing with fire) is a distinctive art form offering the unique combination of seeing what you draw as well as feeling it, which creates pictures that appear almost lifelike.

2. Ann Reiser
The Shepherd's Purse
Home grown wool and mohair that has been spun, woven or felted into garments and wall pieces.



9. Davida Schulman
Contemporary realistic work filled with pattern and brilliant color. Media are watercolor, acrylic and oils and occasionally prints and drawings.

Art with Nature
Emily has a passion for working with gourds. She visualizes and draws the design and cuts it out forming puzzle-like pieces that fit back together. The gourd is further embellished with pyrography and staining with inks and dyes.

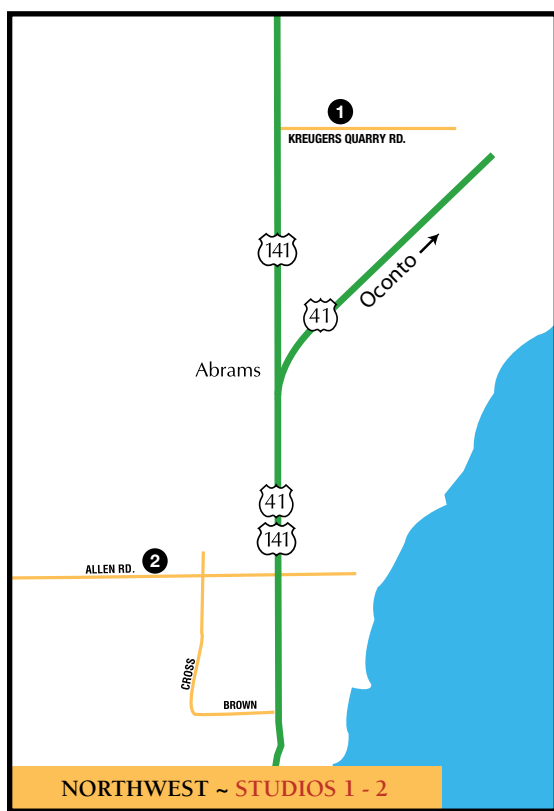
8. Molly M. Johnson

Original oil and watercolor paintings displayed in the century old mill downtown in Denmark.



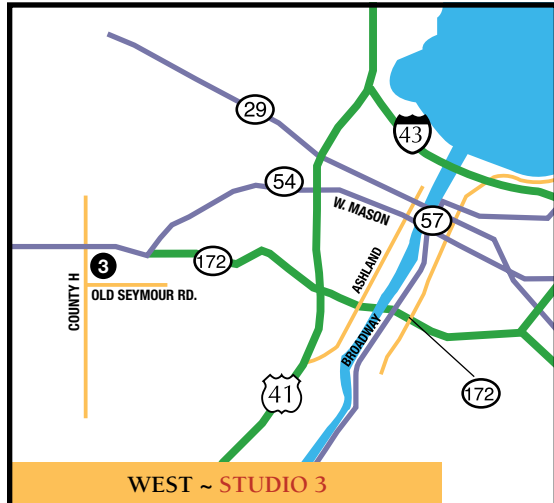
15. Bren Sibilsky

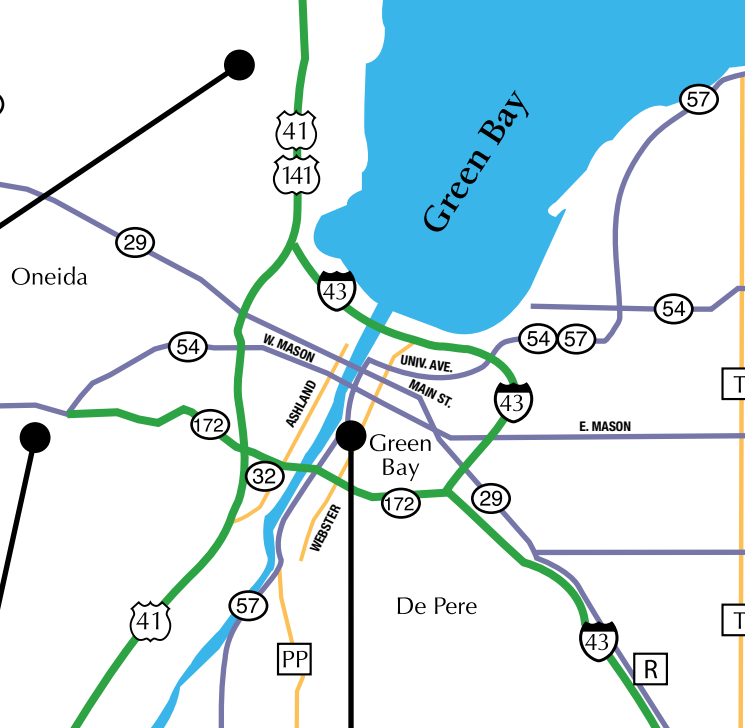


NORTHWEST ~ STUDIOS 1 - 2

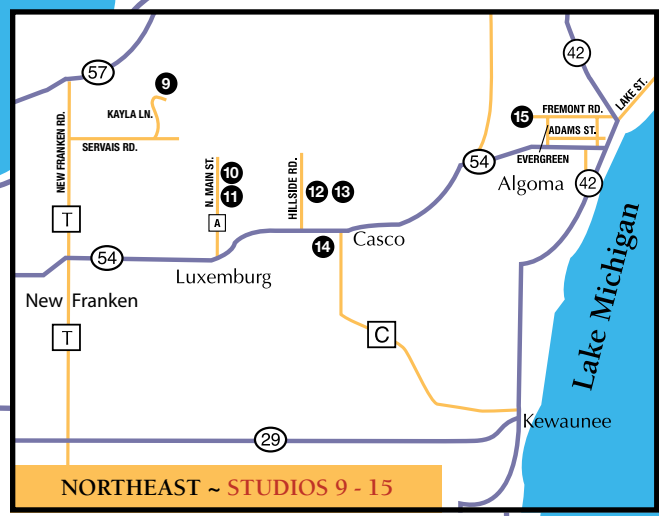


WEST ~ STUDIO 3

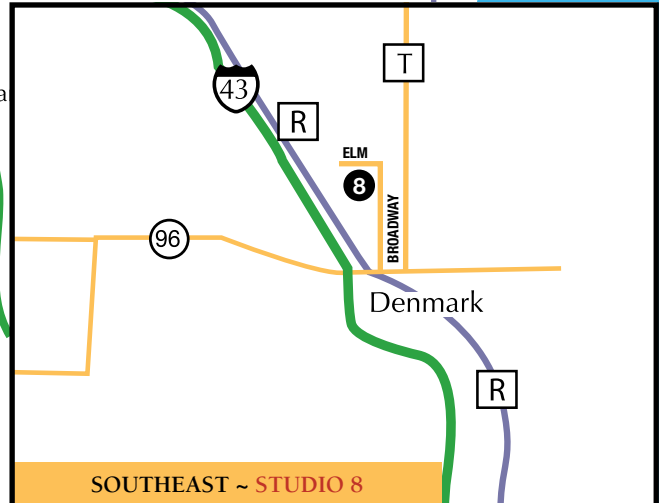
